We have confessions here every week on Wednesday from 6-6:45 p.m., on Saturday at 4:30 p.m., and on Sunday before the Masses. During Lent, we'll also have confessions every Monday evening after the Stations of the Cross, which begin at 6:30 p.m. If none of these times work for you, you can always contact me to make other arrangements.

Please be assured of my prayers in a special way during these sacred days of Lent!
