Bishop Brossart High School is proud to announce that we have reached the Public Fundraising Phase of the Baseball and Softball Complex addition at the MAC. Since October 2023, our Capital Campaign Committee has been working diligently with community partners to help us reach our goal of four million dollars. We are pleased to announce that we can proceed with building our dream complex for our beloved BBHS Mustang Community.
